

# Check List for SSAC Applications

The following is a check list only to ensure that your application is complete and understood accurately. This page is need not be included with the application.

## Informal SSAC:

For an informal SSAC, there are no responsibilities other than:

- We have read and agreed that the SnowStar General Statements are consistent with our own community;
- We have indicated on the application that we wish to be recognized as an Informal SSAC
- An appropriate representative has signed the application on our group's behalf.

## Intentional SSAC:

For an Intentional SSAC the responsibilities are:

- We have read and agreed that the SnowStar General Statements will guide the activities and practices of our group.
- We understand that our leadership must be composed of SnowStar members in good standing.
- We have indicated on the application form that we wish to form an Intentional SSAC.
- An appropriate representative has signed the application on our group's behalf.
- We have included a twenty-five dollar (Canadian Funds) annual group registration fee payable to the SnowStar Institute of Religion.

## Institutional SSAC:

For an Institutional SSAC the responsibilities are:

- We have read and agreed that the SnowStar General Statements are consistent with our Institution.
- We have indicated on the application form that we wish to be recognized as an Institutional SSAC.
- We have passed and included a copy of the motion from our Board, Committee, or official body that empowers us to apply for the status of an Institutional SSAC.
- An appropriate representative has signed the application on our Institution's behalf.
- We have included a fifty-five dollar (Canadian Funds) annual Intuition registration fee payable to the SnowStar Institute of Religion.
